


INTRODUCTION

The Scheme of Central Schools was approved in November 1962 by the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the Second Central Pay Commission in which it was recommended that the Government should develop a scheme to provide uninterrupted education to the wards of transferable Central Government employees. Consequently, Central School Organization was started as a unit of the Ministry of Education (Now Ministry of Human Resource Development) of the Govt. of India.

Initially, 20 Regimental schools were adopted, which were functioning at places having large concentration of defence personnel as Central Schools during the academic year 1963-64.

The Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) was registered as a society under the Societies Registration Act (XXI of 1860) on 15th December 1965. The primary aim of the Sangathan is to provide, establish, endow, maintain, control and manage the Central Schools (Kendriya Vidyalayas) located all over India and abroad.

KVS is an autonomous body under MHRD fully financed by the Government. Over the years, the number of Kendriya Vidyalayas steadily increased to 1183 as on 01.05.2018.



OBJECTIVES

- (a) To cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government employees including Defence and Para-military personnel by providing a common education programme.
- (b) To pursue excellence and set the pace in the field of school education.
- (c) To initiate and promote experimentation and innovations in education in collaboration with other bodies like the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) etc.
- (d) To develop the spirit of national integration and create a sense of "Indianness" among children.

In pursuance of the above objectives, the Kendriya Vidyalayas have the following features and norms:

- Common textbooks and bilingual (English & Hindi) medium of instruction.
- All Kendriya Vidyalayas are affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).
- All Kendriya Vidyalayas are co-educational composite schools.
- Teaching of three languages English, Hindi & Sanskrit from Class VI to VIII is compulsory. In Classes IX and X, any two languages out of English, Hindi and Sanskrit can be opted. Sanskrit can also be taken as elective subject at + 2 stages.
- Through an ideal and updated methodology, KVS strives to maintain excellence in academic pursuits.



ADMINISTRATION

(a) Sangathan has 03 tier Management Structure

- Headquarter at New Delhi.
- 25 Regional Offices, to manage schools put under their Administrative Control.
- Kendriya Vidyalayas, spread all over the country & abroad.

(b) Functioning of KVS

- KVS has its General Body called Sangathan comprising of 31 Members.
- The Board of Governors has 25 Members.
- 04 Standing Committees constituted to assist the BoG i.e. Academic Advisory Committee, Finance Committee, Works Committee and Establishment & Administration Committee.

The Minister for Human Resource Development is ex-officio Chairman of the Sangathan. The policy and guidelines issued by the Sangathan and its Board of Governors are executed by the Commissioner who is the Executive Head of the Sangathan.

2. PROCEDURE OF OPENING OF KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

Kendriya Vidyalayas are opened on receipt of proposal from Sponsoring Authorities, viz (a) Ministry (b) Department of Govt. of India (c) State Governments (d) UTs, on the conditions that required suitable land as per KVS norms is provided free of cost on lease / permanent grant basis and also the temporary accommodation is provided to run the Vidyalaya till KVS constructs



Vidyalayas were opened on the assurance that the Sponsoring Authority will provide land and proper physical infrastructure to run the Vidyalaya. However from the year 2014, the criteria for opening of Kendriya Vidyalayas have been changed. The present provision includes transfer of land prior to opening of a Kendriya Vidyalaya and provide temporary accommodation and to handover the possession prior to opening of new KV. The requisite extent of land to be provided free of cost is as under:

The sponsoring authority should provide desirable extent of land for creation of all sports and other infrastructural facilities and for future expansion of KV. Water and electricity lines/ supply and approach road up to the site offered by sponsoring authority for construction of permanent school building will also be provided by the sponsoring authorities at their cost.

Essential Factors for considering land suitability:

- Road connectivity to the offered plot.
- Low lying and undulated plot should be avoided to minimize the development cost.



- Availability of water supply up to site.
- Availability of Electrical connection up to site.
- Plot having HT line will not be considered.
- · Land having LT line, nallah / drain passing the plot, will be avoided.
- Preference to be given to rectangular plots.
- Land should be free from encroachment and Court cases.

It is to endeavor of the KVS to construct permanent school building for all the functional Kendriya Vidyalayas in the least possible time for the benefit of the children to have conducive environment required for teaching learning process.

3. SALIENT FEATURES OF SCHEME

As per the terms and conditions accepted prior to opening of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Sponsoring Authorities will provide adequate suitable land free of cost and safe temporary building for running of Vidyalaya till KVS constructs its own permanent school building.

(a) Procedure for transfer of land:

- In respect of Kendriya Vidyalayas sponsored by the Ministry of Defence, Sanction Order for transfer of free of cost Defence land on 99 years' lease basis is issued by the Ministry of Defence.
- For Kendriya Vidyalayas located in Para-Military Stations (CRPF, BSF, ITBP, CISF, Assam Riffles etc.), Sanction Order for transfer of land is issued by the Directorate General of the concerned posts under Ministry of Home Affairs for 99 years' lease basis.
- For Kendriya Vidyalayas located in Railway Establishments, Sanction Order for transfer of land is issued by the General Manager of concerned Railway with the concurrence of Railway Board for 99 years' lease basis.



- In respect of Civil Sector Kendriya Vidyalayas, Sponsored by the State/UT Government, the land is provided either on lease basis or on permanent grant basis (i.e. change of title in favour of KVS) and Sanction Order of State Govt. /UT for transfer of land is issued by the District Collector or the authority to whom the powers have been delegated by the State Government.
- From KVS side, Additional Commissioner (Admn) is the Competent Authority to sign the lease deed on behalf of KVS in view of the provisions laid down in the Memorandum of Associations of KVS.
- The lease documents prepared on the basis of Standing Lease Agreement duly vetted by the concerned Ministry is sent to KVS (HQ). After the signatures of the Additional Commissioner (Admn), the lease deed is registered in the Local Revenue Office.
- Lease deed is not required wherever land is transferred by the State government / UTs on permanent grant basis.

At present, KVS has to construct permanent school buildings in 277 Kendriya Vidyalayas out of which in 71 Kendriya Vidyalayas, construction work is in progress and School Buildings are expected to be completed within 2-3 financial years. In 113 cases, construction of school buildings is under planning and AA&ES will be issued on receipt of plans and estimates from the construction agencies subject to availability of funds. In remaining 80 KVs, land is yet to be transferred by the sponsoring authorities (Annexure-I).

However, for Kendriya Vidyalayas located in hard stations / remote areas/mock hills / disturbed areas where it is difficult to get proper accommodation up to living standards of the staff members, KVS considers



construction of 100% accommodation subject to availability of adequate land and budget.

(e) Sports Facilities

Subject to availability of land, KVS provides following sports facilities for improvement of sports skills among the students besides teaching excellence:

- (i) PRIMARY: Play area with open spaces near primary block for play equipment like Playing Slides, Wave Slides, Swings, Seasaw, Horizontal Ladders, Ring, Gland-slip, Climbing Apparatus, Merry-Go-Round etc.
- (ii) SENIOR SECONDARY: Hockey Field, Athletic Track, Volley ball Court, Basket Ball Court, Kho-kho Lawn, Lawn Tennis Court, Kabaddi ground, Gymnastic area etc.

(f) Space Norms

School Buildings of Kendriya Vidyalayas is planned on the basis approved Space Norms as given at (Annexure II).

4. SYSTEM / PROCEDURE OF EXECUTION OF WORKS

As Sangathan has no in-house agency in its own for planning, designing and execution of construction works, all the construction work of KVS are ordinarily entrusted to the following Government Agencies as Deposit Work:

- (i) CPWD
- (ii) MES
- (iii) State PWD

However, sometime above said agencies do not undertake the construction projects. In that situation KVS does the empanelment of other agencies like Public Sector Undertakings of Central Govt. / State Govt. /Semi-Govt. by following the provisions under Rule 133(3) of GFR, 2017. After following the prescribed procedure and provisions of GFR, bids for determining lowest service charges are invited and the work is entrusted to the agencies. An agreement between KVS and the agency is also signed for designing and supervising the works.

The following stages are involved in this regard:

- (i) After transfer of land, formal request to the Chief Engineer for preparation of preliminary targets as per KVS Space Norms.
- (ii) Approval of preliminary drawings by KVS.
- (iii) Submission of preliminary estimates planned on DPAR/DSAR of CPWD and schedule of rates of MES.
- (iv) Issue of Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanctioned (AA&ES) and release of 1st installment of funds to take up the work.
- (v) Tender action by the construction agencies
- (vi) Start of work by the contractor
- (vii) Monitoring and release of funds on monthly progress report received from the In-charge of Work duly counter signed by the Principal.
- (viii) Monitoring Committee: A Committee consisting of the following is constituted at the Vidyalaya level for regular monitoring of major / minor works sanctioned by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan:

The meeting of the Monitoring Committee is convened once in a month to:

- Ensure timely start of work;
- Inspect quality / workmanship of construction and review progress of the work;
- Review of the schedule of the work (BAR Chart) to ensure completion of the work in time;
- Expedite handling over / taking over of completed work and rectification of defects.

(ix) Quality of construction work:

- All KVS works are entrusted to Govt. Construction Agencies viz CPWD / MES and other Central / State Public Sector Undertakings on "Deposit Work" system from concept to commissioning stage, in which construction agencies are fully responsible for planning, designing and execution with quality construction.
- Before start of work, KVS ensures that the structural drawings submitted by construction agencies (other than CPWD/MES) are vetted by IIT and Technical Sanction is accorded by their Competent Authority.
- Third Party Quality assurance by HT/NIT/Govt. Engineering Colleges / organization is undertaken by construction agencies at various stages of construction to ascertain the quality of construction.

5. ESTIMATION / PROJECT COST / FUNDING PATTERN OF THE SCHEME

In the case of CPWD, preliminary estimates are framed based on DPAR with updated cost index and in the case of MES, estimates are based on MES standard schedule of rates.

The present cost of construction of school building (2 Section each from Class I to XII) is Rs.18.23 Crore (approximately). However, this cost may vary place to place as per site conditions, availability of manpower in remote areas / North East Region and revision of cost index from time to time.

FUNDING PATTERN OF THE SCHEME:

The Govt. provides Grants for creation of Capital Assets, out of which funds are released for construction activities. AA&ES is issued along with release of 1st installment of fund to take up the work. Next installments of funds are released on submission of Physical and Financial Progress of the work in KVS format submitted by the construction agency duly counter signed by the Principal.

The tentative funding pattern of project is as under:

6. COMPONENTS OF THE SCHEME

A comprehensive infrastructure involves the following facilities:

- (a) Construction of school building
- (b) Sports facilities
- (c) Staff Quarters
- (d) Campus Development
- (e) Compound wall with sentry post
- (f) External water supply & Electric connection

8. BUDGET REQUIREMENT / ALLOCATION OF BUDGET FOR THE SCHEME FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

For establishment and running of the Kendriya Vidyalayas across the country, Government of India provides financial support to the KVS in the form of Grants in Aid under three distinct heads – 'Salary', 'General' and 'Creation Capital Assets'. In addition, KVS generates funds by collecting user charges from students.

Major components under 'Salary', 'General' and 'Creation of Capital Assets'

Salary

Besides salary of teaching and non-teaching staff, the expenditure on leave encashment, TA, LTC, Medical reimbursement and CEA are met from the GIA (Salaries).

General

Besides payment of pension, retirement benefits(gratuity, commutation of pension, leave encashment etc.) the management contribution to CPF, contribution to the New Pension System as well as expenditure on repairs and maintenance is met out from GIA 'General.
